Volunteers Needed for Carroll County History Project

Westminster, Maryland (February 13, 2009) – The Community Media Center (CMC) is seeking volunteers to interview local residents for the Carroll County History Project, an initiative to document the history of the county and the memories of its residents. A component of the project, Carroll County Remembers, is a permanent video archive of interviews from those who have lived here.

The CMC offers History Project volunteer training on a monthly basis that includes interviewing techniques and camera skills. They also coordinate interviews between History Project volunteers and Carroll County residents who are interested in sharing their memories for the archive, a permanent collection of interviews with Carroll's residents.

The next volunteer training workshop is scheduled for Saturday, March 21 from 10 am until 2 pm at the Community Media Center located at 1301 Washington Road in Westminster.
