Governor's Visit to Westminster to Air on Public Access

Westminster, Maryland (April 23, 2009) – On Friday, April 24, 2009 the Community Media Center of Carroll County (CMC) will cover Maryland Governor Martin O'Malley's "Capital for a Day" visit to Westminster. This is the first stop of the year for the Governor's monthly program which is intended to familiarize state officials with local issues. It is also the first time Westminster has received the designation.

The CMC will follow the Governor and his staff as they greet citizens and merchants along Main Street, beginning at Longwell Avenue and ending at the Carroll Arts Center. This will be followed by an Official Cabinet meeting at McDaniel College where O'Malley will declare Westminster Maryland's "Capital for a Day."

Additional CMC coverage will include meetings with members of the Governor's Executive Cabinet and their local counterparts. Department of Natural Resources Secretary John Griffin will meet with Carroll County Parks and Recreation officials and participate in the City of Westminster's King Park Ribbon Cutting Ceremony along with Mayor Thomas K. Ferguson. Maryland Department of Environment Deputy Secretary Bob Summers and City officials will dedicate the newly renovated Cranberry Run Water Treatment Plant.

The Governor's "Capital for a Day" activities will be aired in segments beginning in May on cable channel 23, Carroll County's Town and Community Channel. Check the CMC's website at www.cmcmd.tv for program times or to view the video on demand.
